
WORLD WIDE VILLAGE ~ INTERNSHIPS ~







WELCOME!

We are so excited that you are considering joining us as an intern in Haiti and know that God has called you to be a part of what He is doing there. The intern program at World Wide Village (WWV) offers college students a unique opportunity to spend time serving in Haiti. Interns will have the opportunity to engage with the local Haitian culture while serving in their area of study.

There are many reasons for choosing to become an Intern with World Wide Village. Some may be testing the waters and considering long-term missions. Some want to dedicate their time to making a difference in the world. Others may be looking to fill a ministry internship requirement as part of their formal education. Our hope is that all interns leave Haiti knowing they have both impacted lives and have been transformed themselves.

INTERNSHIP DETAILS



Our core areas of service include education, healthcare, construction, and agriculture. As we always strive to tell our story better, communications and marketing majors are also very helpful to further our cause. Interns are a key ingredient in the expansion of WWV projects in Haiti.



Projects may include, but are not limited to... journalism, construction, leading school workshops, conducting Bible clubs, teaching English, community outreach, providing healthcare, conducting public health surveys, curriculum development, teacher training, photography, graphic design, marketing, etc.



Intern positions require a great deal of flexibility, patience, and perseverance. Interns must be willing to serve without recognition, love and show grace to all no matter what, both lead and work as part of a team working towards the ultimate goal of transforming impoverished communities and sharing the gospel.

Intern Requirements

- Follower of Jesus Christ; actively seeking to serve Him.
- Completed at least two years of post-high school education.
- Previous cross-culture experience preferred.
- Demonstrated spiritual and social maturity.
- Available and committed to serving with World Wide Village. Minimum time commitments vary depending on the time of year, but usually two months.
- Willingness to sign a covenant of behavior and adhere to the code of conduct.
- Current passport (or passport in application process).
- Bi-lingual candidates, especially French or Haitian Creole, will receive some preferential consideration. Opportunities to learn the local language may also be available to those serving as interns in Haiti.

Intern Application Process & Fees

- Submit General Application and Internship Essays (online).
- Submit three References:
 Pastor/Mentor,
 Professor/Employer, and Peer.
- Complete a phone interview. You will be contacted to schedule this after your application has been reviewed and approved.
- Register online. You will receive instructions after acceptance.
- Begin fundraising for internship fee.
 *Fee for Haiti interns depends on length of service.
- After your selection, you will be counseled about booking your plane ticket.
- Fundraise, if necessary, and submit final payment.

- Internship Costs \$800 per month (Room & board, administrative costs, field ministry costs, transportation, travel insurance, training, etc.)
- Room & Board: WWV provides
 housing, groceries for meals and
 laundry facilities. Interns will be
 covered by an extended stay
 traveler's insurance policy.
 Housing for our interns is provided
 at our guesthouse and may
 require flexibility depending on
 mission team census.
- Flights: \$500-\$800 Flight to Port au Prince, Haiti
 ESTIMATE ONLY
- Fundraising: Past interns have experienced a great deal of success in their efforts to raise personal support from friends, relatives, and others. We can assist with this if needed.
